The Pacific Environmental Science Centre laboratories provide scientific data for freshwater quality monitoring programs, the Shellfish Water Classification Program (SWCP), wildlife and environmental enforcement related investigations, and emerging priorities. The chemistry section of the laboratory specializes in environmental contaminants analysis, oil spills forensics and identification of unknown contaminants in the environment. The SWCP classifies the water for shellfish harvesting off the BC coast by undertaking water quality monitoring and sanitary surveys.

Visitors will be able to visit chemistry and biology labs as well as the freshwater and shellfish microbiology labs. There will be a video presentation of wildlife enforcement (Fifth Estate) and both environment and wildlife enforcement officers there.

*Please note: no backpacks are allowed in the lab and children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
