The successful candidate must have the following qualifications:

- 1. Completion of senior secondary school or its equivalent.
- 2. Completion of a Bachelor of Technology in Forensic Investigation, Crime and Intelligence Analysis from British Columbia Institute of Technology; OR Completion of a post-secondary degree in social sciences, criminal justice or criminology and a minimum of one year's experience within the last five years in crime and statistical analysis and research.
- 3. Proficient in intermediate Word and intermediate Excel as demonstrated through testing (70% pass rate required).
- 4. Minimum of three years' experience within the last five years working in a police municipal support environment using information and intelligence database systems such as, but not limited to, ROSS, CPIC, PRIME, JUSTIN, ArcGIS, and open source systems.
- 5. Shortlisted applicants must successfully pass a National Test for Intelligence Analysts administered by the RCMP Intelligence Standards and Program Development (ISPD) Section in order to proceed to the interview stage.
- 6. Ability to obtain and maintain RCMP Top Secret Level Security Clearance.
