Returning to the Program after receiving a P1B- Cannot Continue Letter

This document is to inform you how to return to the program after being required to discontinue.

If you plan to return to the program, you must be out of the program for a minimum of one academic term. During your time away from the program, you must undertake activities that show you can successfully complete the program. These might include:

- Making up courses through PTS or by taking equivalents at another institution
- Successfully completing other courses or another program
- Successfully redoing prerequisites so you have a stronger background and are better prepared
- Working in a related area
- Completing counselling and/or student success courses or programs

To return, apply online for Readmission to the program. When you apply, complete the Readmission form and include it with your application. In the form, describe how you will be successful if you are allowed to return. This could include what you have been doing since you left the program including evidence of any courses with grades, letter of reference from employer, etc.

The department will review your application and decide if you will be accepted back into the program. You will be notified by Admissions of the decision.
